

Cookie Policy Study Association Clio

This is the Cookie Policy for the website of the Study Association Clio, accessible at www.clio.nl.

1. What Are Cookies

- 1.1. As is common practice with almost all professional websites this site uses cookies, which are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer to improve your experience. This document describes what information is gathered, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies. We will also share how you can prevent these cookies from being stored. However, this may downgrade or 'break' certain elements of the site's functionality.

2. How We Use Cookies

- 2.1. We use cookies for a variety of reasons, detailed below. Unfortunately, in most cases there are no industry standard options for disabling cookies without completely disabling the functionality and features they add to this site. It is recommended that you leave on all cookies if you are not sure whether you need them or not, in case they are required for providing a service that you use.

3. Disabling Cookies

- 3.1. You can prevent the setting of cookies by adjusting the settings on your browser (see your browser *Help* for how to do this). Be aware that disabling cookies will affect the functionality of this and many other websites that you visit. Disabling cookies will usually result in also disabling certain functionalities and features of this site. Therefore, it is recommended that you do not disable cookies. 4. The Cookies We Set

4.1. Account related cookies

If you create an account with us, then we will use cookies for the management of the signup process and general administration. These cookies will usually be deleted when you log out, however in some cases, they may remain afterwards to remember your site preferences when logged out.

4.2. Login related cookies

We use cookies when you are logged in so that we can register that you were logged in. This prevents you from having to log in every single time you visit a new page. These cookies are typically removed or cleared when you log out to ensure that you can only access restricted features and areas when logged in.

4.3. Email newsletters related cookies

This site offers newsletter or email subscription services and cookies may be used to remember if you are already registered and whether to show certain notifications which might only be valid to subscribed/unsubscribed users.

4.4. Orders processing related cookies

This site offers e-commerce or payment facilities. Some cookies are essential to ensure that your order is remembered between pages so that we can process it properly.

4.5. Site preferences cookies

In order to provide you with a great experience on this site, we provide the functionality to set your preferences for how this site runs when you use it. In order to remember your preferences, we need to set cookies so that this information can be used whenever you interact with a page that is affected by your preferences.

4.6. New Relic

A cookie from *New Relic* monitors how the website performs. Based on this, we can see what the loading time of a web page is and spot any errors that might need fixing.

5. Third-Party Cookies

5.1. In some special cases, we also use cookies provided by trusted third parties. The following section details which third-party cookies you might encounter through this site.

- a) This site uses **Google Analytics** which is one of the most widespread and trusted analytics solutions used for helping us to understand how you use the site and ways that we can improve your experience. These cookies may track things such as how much time you spend on the site and the pages that you visit, so we can continue to produce engaging content.

- b) We also use **social media buttons and/or plugins** on this site that allow you to connect with your social network in various ways.
